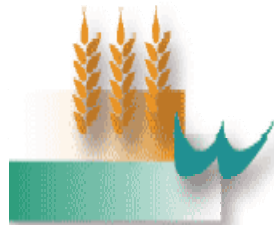
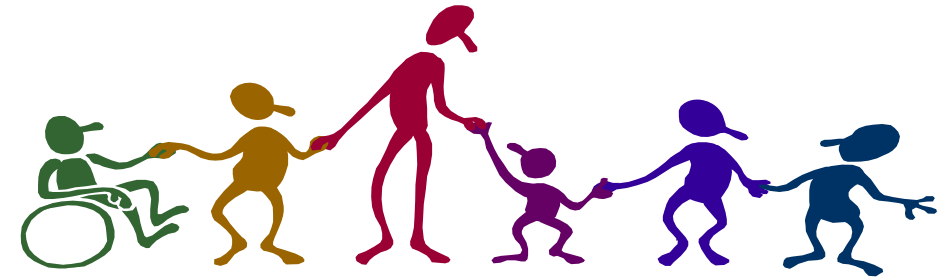
Mission & Ministry - working Hand in Hand
