

JOHN KNOX PRESBYTERY
Pulpit Supply List Policy

1. Pulpit Supply is intended as a Sunday by Sunday relationship. If the church is intending to invite the same supply preacher for more than 2 weeks in any given month, Presbytery approval is required through the Committee on Ministry. If this situation occurs because of an emergency or time constraints, Committee on Ministry must be informed.

2. Persons eligible to be placed on the Pulpit Supply list include:
 - A. Presbyterian ministers who are members in good standing of the John Knox Presbytery are eligible to be placed on the list, or those honorably retired from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) and living within our bounds. If the individual is not a member of the John Knox Presbytery, an ethics and background checks will be required.

 - B. Non-clergy and non-Presbyterians requesting to be placed on the Pulpit Supply must complete the application below.
